## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1722) to improve teleworking in executive agencies by developing a telework program that allows employees to telework at least 20 percent of the hours worked in every 2 administrative workweeks, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 1722) to improve teleworking in executive agencies by de-  
4 veloping a telework program that allows employees to  
5 telework at least 20 percent of the hours worked in every

1 2 administrative workweeks, and for other purposes. All  
2 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived  
3 except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI.  
4 The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
5 ommended by the Committee on Oversight and Govern-  
6 ment Reform now printed in the bill, modified by the  
7 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on  
8 Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as  
9 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read.  
10 All points of order against provisions of the bill, as amend-  
11 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered  
12 as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage with-  
13 out intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
14 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
15 minority member of the Committee on Oversight and Gov-  
16 ernment Reform; and (2) one motion to recommit with  
17 or without instructions.
