Mr. POLIS of Colorado, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3585) to guide and provide for United States research, development, and demonstration of solar energy technologies, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3585) to guide and provide for

1 United States research, development, and demonstration  
2 of solar energy technologies, and for other purposes. The  
3 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
4 of order against consideration of the bill are waived except  
5 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General  
6 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
7 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
8 ranking minority member of the Committee on Science  
9 and Technology. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall  
11 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose  
12 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment  
13 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-  
14 mittee on Science and Technology now printed in the bill.  
15 The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute  
16 shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
17 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute  
18 are waived except those arising under clause 10 of rule  
19 XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amend-  
20 ment to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
21 stitute shall be in order except those printed in the report  
22 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.  
23 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order  
24 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member  
25 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall

1 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
2 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
3 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
4 ject to a demand for division of the question. All points  
5 of order against such amendments are waived except those  
6 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion  
7 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
8 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
9 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous  
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
12 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
13 structions.

14       SEC. 2. The Chair may entertain a motion that the  
15 Committee rise only if offered by the chair of the Com-  
16 mittee on Science and Technology or his designee. The  
17 Chair may not entertain a motion to strike out the enact-  
18 ing words of the bill (as described in clause 9 of rule  
19 XVIII).
