3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Student-to-School
- 5 Nurse Ratio Improvement Act of 2009".

1 SEC. 2. REDUCING STUDENT-TO-SCHOOL NURSE RATIOS.

2 Title VIII of the Public Health Service Act (42
3 U.S.C. 296 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the
4 following:

5 **"PART J—SCHOOL NURSES**

6 "SEC. 861. REDUCING STUDENT-TO-SCHOOL NURSE RATIOS.

7 "(a) DEMONSTRATION GRANTS.—The Secretary, act8 ing through the Director of the Centers for Disease Con9 trol and Prevention, may make demonstration grants to
10 eligible States for the purpose of reducing the student-to11 school nurse ratio in public secondary schools, elementary
12 schools, and kindergarten.

13 "(b) REPORT.—Not later than 24 months after the date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary shall 14 submit to the Congress a report on the results of the dem-15 16 onstration grant program carried out under this section, including an evaluation of the effectiveness of the program 17 18 in improving the student-to-school nurse ratios described 19 in subsection (a) and an evaluation of the impact of any resulting enhanced health of students on learning. 20

21 "(c) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section:

"(1) The terms 'elementary school' and 'secondary school' have the meanings given to those
terms in section 9101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.

"(2) The term 'eligible State' means a State in
 which the student-to-school nurse ratio in public sec ondary schools, elementary schools, and kinder garten is 750 or more students to every school
 nurse.

6 "(3) The term 'nurse' means a licensed nurse. 7 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To 8 carry out this section, there are authorized to be appro-9 priated such sums as may be necessary for each of the 10 fiscal years 2010 through 2014.".
