Mr. BINGAMAN (for himself and Mr. UDALL of New Mexico) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

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## A BILL

To withdraw certain land in the State of New Mexico, and  
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Law Enforce-  
5 ment Training Center Protection Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT**

7 **TRAINING CENTER LAND.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—For the purposes of protecting,  
9 operating, and maintaining the Federal Law Enforcement  
10 Training Center in Eddy County, New Mexico, and subject

1 to valid existing rights, the Federal land described in sub-  
2 section (b) is reserved for use by the Secretary of Home-  
3 land Security for the Federal Law Enforcement Training  
4 Center and withdrawn from—

5 (1) entry, appropriation, or disposal under the  
6 public land laws;

7 (2) location, entry, and patent under the mining  
8 laws; and

9 (3) operation of the mineral leasing, mineral  
10 materials, and geothermal leasing laws.

11 (b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The Federal land re-  
12 ferred to in subsection (a) is the approximately 2,700  
13 acres of Federal land generally depicted as the “With-  
14 drawal Area” on the map entitled “FLETC Land With-  
15 drawal” and dated May 4, 2010.

16 (c) WITHDRAWAL PERIOD.—The withdrawal of the  
17 Federal land described in subsection (b) shall remain in  
18 effect for a period of 20 years beginning on the date of  
19 enactment of this Act.

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
