3 **SECTION 1. OHKAY OWINGEH PUEBLO LEASING AUTHOR-**
4 **ITY.**

5 (a) AUTHORIZATION FOR 99-YEAR LEASES.—Sub-
6 section (a) of the first section of the Act of August 9,
7 1955 (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended in the second sen-
8 tence by inserting “and lands held in trust for Ohkay
9 Owingeh Pueblo” after “of land on the Devils Lake Sioux
10 Reservation,”.

1 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
2 section (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or renewed
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
