## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, March 17, 2011, Friday, March 18,  
4 2011, or Saturday, March 19, 2011, on a motion offered  
5 pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority  
6 Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m.  
7 on Tuesday, March 29, 2011, or until the time of

1 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent  
2 resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Sen-  
3 ate recesses or adjourns on any day from Thursday,  
4 March 17, 2011, through Friday, March 25, 2011, on a  
5 motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by  
6 its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or  
7 adjourned until noon on Monday, March 28, 2011, or such  
8 other time on that day as may be specified in the motion  
9 to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly  
10 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-  
11 ever occurs first.

12       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
18 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant  
19 it.
