## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Styrene, ar-ethyl-,polymer with divinylbenzene and styrene beads having low ash content.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STYRENE, AR-ETHYL-,POLYMER WITH**  
4 **DIVINYLBENZENE AND STYRENE BEADS HAV-**  
5 **ING LOW ASH CONTENT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.40 of the Har-  
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8 Styrene, ar-ethyl-,polymer with divinylbenzene and styrene  
9 beads having low ash content) is amended by striking the

1 date in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/  
2 2015”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
