To ensure objective, independent review of task and delivery orders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Independent Task and
5 Delivery Order Review Extension Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF SUNSET DATE FOR CERTAIN PRO-**
2 **TESTS OF TASK AND DELIVERY ORDER CON-**
3 **TRACTS.**

4 Section 4106(f)(3) of title 41, United States Code,
5 is amended to read as follows:

6 “(3) EFFECTIVE PERIOD.—Paragraph 1(B)
7 and paragraph (2) of this subsection shall not be in
8 effect after September 30, 2016.”.

9 **SEC. 3. USE OF EXISTING RESOURCES TO PROCESS TASK**
10 **AND DELIVERY ORDER PROTESTS.**

11 *No amounts are authorized to be appropriated for the*
12 *specific purpose of processing protests authorized under sec-*
13 *tion 4106(f) of title 41, United States Code, as amended*
14 *by section 2, and all such protests shall be processed using*
15 *the existing resources of the Government Accountability Of-*
16 *fice and executive agencies.*
