6 **CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964.**

7 The rotunda of the United States Capitol is author-
8 ized to be used on June 24, 2014, for a ceremony to com-
9 memorate the 50th anniversary of the enactment of the

1 Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the significant impact the
2 Act had on the Civil Rights movement. Physical prepara-
3 tions for the conduct of the ceremony shall be carried out
4 in accordance with such conditions as may be prescribed
5 by the Architect of the Capitol.
