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## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making continuing appropriations for the National Nuclear Security Administration for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*

2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out of

4       any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,

5       and out of applicable corporate or other revenues, receipts,

6       and funds, for the National Nuclear Security Administra-

7       tion for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes, namely:

8       SEC. 101. (a) Such amounts as may be necessary,

9       at a rate for operations as provided in the Full-Year Con-

10       tinuing Appropriations Act, 2013 (division F of Public

11       Law 113-6) and under the authority and conditions pro-

12       vided in such Act, for continuing projects or activities (in-

1 eluding the costs of direct loans and loan guarantees) of  
 2 the National Nuclear Security Administration that are not  
 3 otherwise specifically provided for in this joint resolution  
 4 or in the Pay Our Military Act of September 30, 2013,  
 5 that were conducted in fiscal year 2013, and for which  
 6 appropriations, funds, or other authority were made avail-  
 7 able by such Act under the following headings:

8           (1) “Weapons Activities”.

9           (2) “Defense Nuclear Nonproliferation”.

10          (3) “Naval Reactors”.

11          (4) “Office of the Administrator”.

12          (b) The rate for operations provided by subsection (a)  
 13 for each account shall be calculated to reflect the full  
 14 amount of any reduction required in fiscal year 2013 pur-  
 15 suant to—

16           (1) any provision of division G of the Consoli-  
 17 dated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act,  
 18 2013 (Public Law 113–6), including section 3004;  
 19 and

20           (2) the Presidential sequestration order dated  
 21 March 1, 2013, except as attributable to budget au-  
 22 thority made available by the Disaster Relief Appro-  
 23 priations Act, 2013 (Public Law 113–2).

1       ~~SEC. 102.~~ Appropriations made by section 101 shall  
2 be available to the extent and in the manner that would  
3 be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.

4       ~~SEC. 103.~~ Unless otherwise provided for in this joint  
5 resolution or in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal  
6 year 2014, appropriations and funds made available and  
7 authority granted pursuant to this joint resolution shall  
8 be available until whichever of the following first occurs:  
9 (1) the enactment into law of an appropriation for any  
10 project or activity provided for in this joint resolution; (2)  
11 the enactment into law of the applicable appropriations  
12 Act for fiscal year 2014 without any provision for such  
13 project or activity; or (3) December 15, 2013.

14       ~~SEC. 104.~~ Expenditures made pursuant to this joint  
15 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation,  
16 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-  
17 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is  
18 enacted into law.

19       ~~SEC. 105.~~ This joint resolution shall be implemented  
20 so that only the most limited funding action of that per-  
21 mitted in the joint resolution shall be taken in order to  
22 provide for continuation of projects and activities.

23       ~~SEC. 106.~~ Amounts made available under section 101  
24 for civilian personnel compensation and benefits in each  
25 department and agency may be apportioned up to the rate

1 for operations necessary to avoid furloughs within such de-  
 2 partment or agency, consistent with the applicable appro-  
 3 priations Act for fiscal year 2013, except that such author-  
 4 ity provided under this section shall not be used until after  
 5 the department or agency has taken all necessary actions  
 6 to reduce or defer non-personnel-related administrative ex-  
 7 penses.

8       SEC. 107. It is the sense of Congress that this joint  
 9 resolution may also be referred to as the “Nuclear Weapon  
 10 Security & Non-Proliferation Act”.

11       This joint resolution may be cited as the “National  
 12 Nuclear Security Administration Continuing Appropria-  
 13 tions Resolution, 2014”.

14       *the following sum is appropriated, out of any money*  
 15 *in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal*  
 16 *year ending September 30, 2014, and for other purposes,*  
 17 *namely:*

18                               *DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE*

19                               *PROCUREMENT*

20                               *PROCUREMENT, DEFENSE-WIDE*

21       *For an additional amount for “Procurement, Defense-*  
 22 *Wide”, \$225,000,000, to remain available until September*  
 23 *30, 2015, which shall be for the Secretary of Defense to pro-*  
 24 *vide to the Government of Israel for the procurement of the*  
 25 *Iron Dome defense system to counter short-range rocket*

1 *threats: Provided, That such funds shall be transferred im-*  
 2 *mediately only through an exchange of letters to address*  
 3 *emergent operations in support of Operation Protective*  
 4 *Edge, notwithstanding section 3.1.3.2.1 of the U.S.-Israel*  
 5 *Iron Dome Procurement Agreement: Provided further, That*  
 6 *nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to apply to*  
 7 *previously appropriated funds for the procurement of Iron*  
 8 *Dome: Provided further, That such amount is designated*  
 9 *by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to*  
 10 *section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-*  
 11 *gency Deficit Control Act of 1985.*

12 *This joint resolution may be cited as the “Emergency*  
 13 *Supplemental Appropriations Resolution, 2014”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill making an emergency supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, to provide funding to Israel for the Iron Dome defense system to counter short-range rocket threats.”.
