Mr. BOUSTANY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To authorize certain Department of Veterans Affairs major medical facility leases, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Local Access
5 Act".

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2013 MAJOR MED-**
7 **ICAL FACILITY LEASES.**

8 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out the
9 following major medical facility leases in fiscal year 2013

1 at the locations specified, and in an amount for each lease
2 not to exceed the amount shown for such location:

3 (1) For a clinical research and pharmacy co-
4 ordinating center, Albuquerque, New Mexico, an
5 amount not to exceed \$9,560,000.

6 (2) For a community based outpatient clinic,
7 Brick, New Jersey, an amount not to exceed
8 \$7,280,000.

9 (3) For a new primary care and dental clinic
10 annex, Charleston, South Carolina, an amount not
11 to exceed \$7,070,000.

12 (4) For the Cobb County Community Based
13 Outpatient Clinic, Cobb County, Georgia, an amount
14 not to exceed \$6,409,000.

15 (5) For the Leeward Outpatient Healthcare Ac-
16 cess Center, Honolulu, Hawaii, including a co-lo-
17 cated clinic with the Department of Defense and the
18 co-location of the Honolulu Regional Office of the
19 Veterans Benefits Administration and the Kapolei
20 Vet Center of the Department of Veterans Affairs,
21 an amount not to exceed \$15,887,000.

22 (6) For a community based outpatient clinic,
23 Johnson County, Kansas, an amount not to exceed
24 \$2,263,000.

1 (7) For a replacement community based out-
2 patient clinic, Lafayette, Louisiana, an amount not
3 to exceed \$2,966,000.

4 (8) For a community based outpatient clinic,
5 Lake Charles, Louisiana, an amount not to exceed
6 \$2,626,000.

7 (9) For outpatient clinic consolidation, New
8 Port Richey, Florida, an amount not to exceed
9 \$11,927,000.

10 (10) For an outpatient clinic, Ponce, Puerto
11 Rico, an amount not to exceed \$11,535,000.

12 (11) For lease consolidation, San Antonio,
13 Texas, an amount not to exceed \$19,426,000.

14 (12) For a community based outpatient clinic,
15 San Diego, California, an amount not to exceed
16 \$11,946,000.

17 (13) For an outpatient clinic, Tyler, Texas, an
18 amount not to exceed \$4,327,000.

19 (14) For the Errera Community Care Center,
20 West Haven, Connecticut, an amount not to exceed
21 \$4,883,000.

22 (15) For the Worcester Community Based Out-
23 patient Clinic, Worcester, Massachusetts, an amount
24 not to exceed \$4,855,000.

1 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2014 MAJOR MED-**
2 **ICAL FACILITY LEASES.**

3 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out the
4 following major medical facility leases in fiscal year 2014
5 at the locations specified, and in an amount for each lease
6 not to exceed the amount shown for such location:

7 (1) For the expansion of a community based
8 outpatient clinic, Cape Girardeau, Missouri, an
9 amount not to exceed \$4,232,000.

10 (2) For a multispecialty clinic, Chattanooga,
11 Tennessee, an amount not to exceed \$7,069,000.

12 (3) For the expansion of a community based
13 outpatient clinic, Chico, California, an amount not to
14 exceed \$4,534,000.

15 (4) For a community based outpatient clinic,
16 Chula Vista, California, an amount not to exceed
17 \$3,714,000.

18 (5) For a new research lease, Hines, Illinois, an
19 amount not to exceed \$22,032,000.

20 (6) For a replacement research lease, Houston,
21 Texas, an amount not to exceed \$6,142,000.

22 (7) For a community based outpatient clinic,
23 Lincoln, Nebraska, an amount not to exceed
24 \$7,178,000.

1 (8) For a community based outpatient clinic,
2 Lubbock, Texas, an amount not to exceed
3 \$8,554,000.

4 (9) For a community based outpatient clinic
5 consolidation, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, an
6 amount not to exceed \$8,022,000.

7 (10) For a community based outpatient clinic,
8 Phoenix, Arizona, an amount not to exceed
9 \$20,757,000.

10 (11) For the expansion of a community based
11 outpatient clinic, Redding, California, an amount not
12 to exceed \$8,154,000.

13 (12) For the expansion of a community based
14 outpatient clinic, Tulsa, Oklahoma, an amount not
15 to exceed \$13,269,000.

16 **SEC. 4. SCORING OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
18 budgetary effects of this Act shall be determined by the
19 Office of Management and Budget.

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
