## A BILL

To amend title 14, United States Code, to authorize the Commandant of the Coast Guard to lease tidelands and submerged lands under the control of the Coast Guard for periods longer than 5 years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Submerged  
5 Lands Transportation Development Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LEASE OF TIDELANDS AND SUBMERGED LANDS**  
2 **UNDER CONTROL OF THE COAST GUARD FOR**  
3 **PERIODS LONGER THAN 5 YEARS.**

4 Section 93 of title 14, United States Code, is amend-  
5 ed by adding at the end the following new subsection:

6 “(f) LEASE OF TIDELANDS AND SUBMERGED  
7 LANDS.—(1) Notwithstanding subsection (a)(13), a lease  
8 described in paragraph (2) may be for such term in excess  
9 of 5 years as the Commandant considers appropriate.

10 “(2) A lease referred to in paragraph (1) is a lease  
11 of the following:

12 “(A) Tidelands under the control of the Coast  
13 Guard.

14 “(B) Submerged lands under the control of the  
15 Coast Guard.”.
