## A BILL

To amend the Fair Credit Reporting Act to clarify the ability to use consumer reports in certain cases to establish and enforce child support payments.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Assist-  
5       ance Act of 2014”.

6       **SEC. 2. USE OF CONSUMER REPORTS BY STATE OR LOCAL**  
7       **CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.**

8       Section 604(a) of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15  
9       U.S.C. 1681b(a)) is amended—

10       (1) in paragraph (4)—

1           (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or  
2           determining the appropriate level of such pay-  
3           ments” and inserting “, determining the appro-  
4           priate level of such payments, or enforcing a  
5           child support order, award, agreement, or judg-  
6           ment”;

7           (B) in subparagraph (B), by adding “and”  
8           at the end;

9           (C) by striking subparagraph (C); and

10          (D) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as  
11          subparagraph (C);

12          (2) by striking paragraph (5); and

13          (3) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-  
14          graph (5).
