# **A BILL**

To amend title 11 of the United States Code to require the public disclosure by trusts established under section 524(g) of such title, of quarterly reports that contain detailed information regarding the receipt and disposition of claims for injuries based on exposure to asbestos; and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Furthering Asbestos  
5 Claim Transparency (FACT) Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7       Section 524(g) of title 11, United States Code, is  
8 amended by adding at the end the following:

9       “(8) A trust described in paragraph (2) shall, subject  
10 to section 107—

11           “(A) file with the bankruptcy court, not later  
12 than 60 days after the end of every quarter, a report  
13 that shall be made available on the court’s public  
14 docket and with respect to such quarter—

15                   “(i) describes each demand the trust re-  
16 ceived from, including the name and exposure  
17 history of, a claimant and the basis for any  
18 payment from the trust made to such claimant;  
19 and

20                   “(ii) does not include any confidential med-  
21 ical record or the claimant’s full social security  
22 number; and

23           “(B) upon written request, and subject to pay-  
24 ment (demanded at the option of the trust) for any  
25 reasonable cost incurred by the trust to comply with

1 such request, provide in a timely manner any infor-  
2 mation related to payment from, and demands for  
3 payment from, such trust, subject to appropriate  
4 protective orders, to any party to any action in law  
5 or equity if the subject of such action concerns li-  
6 ability for asbestos exposure.”.

7 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**

8 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Except as provided in sub-  
9 section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this  
10 Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this  
11 Act.

12 (b) **APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**—The amend-  
13 ments made by this Act shall apply with respect to cases  
14 commenced under title 11 of the United States Code be-  
15 fore, on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act.



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
