A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, with respect to the operation of vehicles on certain Wisconsin highways, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN WIS-**
4 **CONSIN HIGHWAYS.**

5 Section 127 of title 23, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(j) OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN WIS-
8 CONSIN HIGHWAYS.—If any segment of the United States
9 Route 41 corridor, as described in section 1105(c)(57) of

1 the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of
2 1991 (105 Stat. 2032; 119 Stat. 1211) is designated as
3 a route on the Interstate System, a vehicle that could op-
4 erate legally on that segment before the date of that des-
5 ignation may continue to operate on that segment, without
6 regard to any requirement under subsection (a).”.
