Mr. PRYOR (for himself, Mr. BLUNT, Mr. FRANKEN, Mr. MORAN, and Mr. COATS) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Budget

A BILL

To exempt from sequestration certain fees of the Food and
Drug Administration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FDA User Fee Protec-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTING FROM SEQUESTRATION CERTAIN USER**
7 **FEEES OF FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION.**

8 The Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control
9 Act of 1985 is amended—

1 (1) in section 255(g)(1)(A) (2 U.S.C.
2 905(g)(1)(A))—

3 (A) by inserting after “Financial Agent
4 Services” the following new item:

5 “Food and Drug Administration, Salaries
6 and Expenses, but only the portion of appro-
7 priations under such account corresponding to
8 fees collected under the Federal Food, Drug,
9 and Cosmetic Act and section 354(r)(1) of the
10 Public Health Service Act (75–9911–0–1–
11 554).”; and

12 (B) by inserting after “Reimbursement to
13 Federal Reserve Banks” the following new
14 item:

15 “Revolving Fund for Certification and
16 Other Services (75–4309–0–3–554).;”; and

17 (2) in section 256(h)(4) (2 U.S.C. 906(h)(4)),
18 by adding at the end the following new subpara-
19 graph:

20 “(G) The portion of administrative ex-
21 penses incurred by the Food and Drug Admin-
22 istration that are funded through fees collected
23 under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic

1 Act and section 354(r)(1) of the Public Health
2 Service Act.”.

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
