1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF NEOTROPICAL MIGRA-**  
2 **TORY BIRD CONSERVATION ACT.**

3 Section 10 of the Neotropical Migratory Bird Con-  
4 servation Act (16 U.S.C. 6109) is amended to read as fol-  
5 lows:

6 **“SEC. 10. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There ~~are~~ *is* authorized to be ap-  
8 propriated to carry out this Act ~~such sums as are nee-~~  
9 ~~essary~~ \$6,500,000 for each of fiscal years 2014 through  
10 2019.

11 “(b) USE OF FUNDS.—Of the amounts made avail-  
12 able under subsection (a) for each fiscal year, not less than  
13 75 percent shall be expended for projects carried out at  
14 a location outside of the United States.”.
