A BILL

To require the completion of the digitization of all remaining paper-based fingerprint records for inclusion in the Automated Biometric Identification System (IDENT) of the Department of Homeland Security.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “IDENT Fingerprint
5 Digitization Completion Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. FINGERPRINT DIGITIZATION.**

2 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Director of U.S. Immigration and
4 Customs Enforcement shall complete the digitization of all
5 remaining paper-based fingerprint records for inclusion in
6 the Automated Biometric Identification System (IDENT)
7 of the Department of Homeland Security.
