Mr. CHAFFETZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To provide an increase in premium pay for United States Secret Service agents performing protective services during 2016, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Overtime Pay for Se-
5 cret Service Agents Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. PREMIUM PAY EXCEPTION IN 2016 FOR WORK AU-**
7 **THORIZED UNDER SECTION 3056 OF TITLE 18.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
9 sion of law, including section 5307 of title 5, United States

1 Code, and subject to subsection (b), during calendar year
2 2016—

3 (1) section 5547(a) of such title shall not apply
4 to an employee who performs work authorized by
5 section 3056(a) of title 18, United States Code; and

6 (2) such an employee may be paid premium pay
7 to the extent that the payment of such pay does not
8 cause the total of basic pay and such premium pay
9 for any pay period for such employee to exceed the
10 annual rate of basic pay payable to level II of the
11 Executive Schedule under section 5313 of title 5,
12 United States Code.

13 (b) TREATMENT OF ADDITIONAL PAY.—To the ex-
14 tent that subsection (a) results in payment of additional
15 premium pay of a type that is normally creditable as basic
16 pay for retirement or any other purpose, such additional
17 pay shall not be considered to be basic pay for any purpose
18 and shall not be used in computing a lump-sum payment
19 for accumulated and accrued annual leave under section
20 5551 of title 5, United States Code.

21 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “em-
22 ployee” means any special agent of the United States Se-
23 cret Service that is a law enforcement officer, but does
24 not include—

1 (1) a member of the United States Secret Serv-
2 ice Uniformed Division; or

3 (2) an officer, employee, agent, or law enforce-
4 ment officer of any other Federal agency.

5 (d) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 118 of the
6 Treasury and General Government Appropriations Act,
7 2001 (Public Law 106–554) is amended by inserting “and
8 except as provided in section 2 of the Overtime Pay for
9 Secret Service Agents Act of 2016,” after “Hereafter,”.

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
