An Act

To amend title 5, United States Code, to clarify the sources of the authority to issue regulations regarding certifications and other criteria applicable to legislative branch employees under Wounded Warriors Federal Leave Act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF SOURCES OF AUTHORITY TO ISSUE
REGULATIONS REGARDING CERTIFICATIONS AND
OTHER CRITERIA APPLICABLE TO LEGISLATIVE
BRANCH EMPLOYEES UNDER WOUNDED WARRIORS
FEDERAL LEAVE ACT.**

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6329(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking “In order” and inserting “(1) In order”;
and

(2) by adding at the end the following new paragraph:
“(2) In the case of an employee of an office of the legislative
branch, the certification described in paragraph (1) shall be pre-
scribed—

“(A) in the case of an employee of the House of Representa-
tives, by the Committee on House Administration of the House
of Representatives;

“(B) in the case of an employee of the Senate, by the
Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate; or

“(C) in the case of an employee of any other office of
the legislative branch, by the head of the office.”.

(b) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 9 months after the date
of the enactment of this Act, the Committee on House Administra-
tion of the House of Representatives, the Committee on Rules
and Administration of the Senate, and the head of each other
office of the legislative branch shall prescribe regulations governing
the application of section 6329 of title 5, United States Code,
including the certification requirement under subsection (c) of such
section, to employees of the House of Representatives, employees
of the Senate, and employees of such office, respectively.
