H. R. 6209

To amend the Fair Housing Act to provide that it is unlawful for any person engaging in a residential real estate-related transaction to discriminate against any person in making available such a transaction, or in the terms or conditions of such a transaction, because all or part of the person's income derives from a source located in Puerto Rico or any other territory of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. MORTGAGE LENDERS PROHIBITED FROM DIS-**
2 **CRIMINATING AGAINST INDIVIDUALS WITH**
3 **INCOME DERIVED FROM A SOURCE LOCATED**
4 **IN PUERTO RICO.**

5 Section 805(a) of the Fair Housing Act (42 U.S.C.
6 3605(a)) is amended by inserting before the period at the
7 end the following: “, or because all or part of the person’s
8 income derives from a source located in Puerto Rico or
9 any other territory of the United States”.

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
