A BILL

To state the policy of the United States on the minimum number of available battle force ships.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Securing the Home-
5 land by Increasing our Power on the Seas Act” or
6 “SHIPS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. POLICY OF THE UNITED STATES ON MINIMUM NUM-**
2 **BER OF BATTLE FORCE SHIPS.**

3 It shall be the policy of the United States to have
4 available, as soon as practicable, not fewer than 355 battle
5 force ships, comprised of the optimal mix of platforms,
6 with funding subject to the annual authorization of appro-
7 priation and the annual appropriation of funds.
