RESOLUTION

To authorize representation by the Senate Legal Counsel
in the case of *Peter P. Truman v. Paula Armstrong,*
et al.

Whereas, two Senate employees, Paula Armstrong and Edie
Smith, have been named as defendants in the case of
Peter P. Truman v. Paula Armstrong, et al., D. Me., cur-
rently on appeal in the United States Court of Appeals
for the First Circuit, No. 18–1095; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the
Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a)
and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to de-
fend employees of the Senate in civil actions relating to
their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-
2 ized to represent Paula Armstrong and Edie Smith in the
3 case of *Peter P. Truman v. Paula Armstrong, et al.*
