#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "ALS Disability Insur-3 ance Access Act of 2019".

# 4 SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF WAITING PERIOD FOR SOCIAL SE5 CURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS 6 FOR DISABLED INDIVIDUALS WITH 7 AMYOTROPHIC LATERAL SCLEROSIS (ALS).

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 223(a)(1) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 423(a)(1)) is amended in the 9 matter following subparagraph (E) by striking "or (ii)" 10 and inserting "(ii) in the case of an individual who has 11 been medically determined to have amyotrophic lateral 12 13 sclerosis, for each month beginning with the first month 14 during all of which the individual is under a disability and in which the individual becomes entitled to such insurance 15 benefits, or (iii)". 16

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
18 this section shall apply with respect to applications for dis19 ability insurance benefits filed after the date of the enact20 ment of this Act.
