KERRY, Democrat, of Boston, MA; born in Denver, CO, December 11, 1943; education: graduated, St. Paul's School, Concord, NH, 1962; B.A., Yale University, New Haven, CT, 1966; J.D., Boston College Law School, Boston, MA, 1976; served, U.S. Navy, discharged with rank of lieutenant; decorations: Silver Star, Bronze Star with Combat "V", three Purple Hearts, various theatre campaign decorations; attorney, admitted to Massachusetts bar, 1976; appointed first assistant district attorney, Middlesex County, 1977; elected lieutenant governor, Massachusetts, 1982; married: Teresa Heinz; committees: chair, Foreign Relations; Commerce, Science, and Transportation; Finance; Small Business and Entrepreneurship; appointed to Democratic Leadership for 104th and 105th Congresses; elected to the U.S. Senate on November 6, 1984; reelected to each succeeding Senate term.

JOHN W. OLVER, Democrat, of Amherst, MA; born in Honesdale, PA, September 3, 1936; education: B.S., Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, 1955; M.A., Tufts University, 1956; taught for 2 years at Franklin Technical Institute, Boston, MA; Ph.D., Massachusetts Institute of Technology, 1961; professional: chemistry professor, University of Massachusetts-Amherst; Massachusetts House, 1968-72; Massachusetts Senate, 1972-91; became first Democrat since the Spanish-American War to represent the First Congressional District, 1991; married: Rose Olver; children: Martha; committees: Appropriations; elected on June 4, 1991, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Silvio Conte, by special election to the 102nd Congress; reelected to each succeeding Congress.
