PART 391—FEES AND CHARGES FOR INSPECTION SERVICES AND LABORATORY ACCREDITATION

§391.1 Scope and purpose.

Fees shall be charged by the Agency for certain specified inspection services provided on a holiday, on an overtime basis, and/or which are voluntary inspection services.

§391.3 Overtime and holiday rate.

The overtime and holiday rate for inspection services provided pursuant to §§307.5, 350.7, 351.8, 351.9, 352.5, 354.101, 355.12, 362.5, and 381.38 shall be \$32.96 per hour, per program employee.

§391.4 Laboratory services rate.

The rate for laboratory services provided pursuant to §§350.7, 351.9, 352.5, 354.101, 355.12, and 362.5 shall be \$52.92 per hour, per program employee.

§391.5 Laboratory accreditation fees.

(a) The annual fee for the initial accreditation and maintenance of accreditation provided pursuant to §§318.21 and 381.153 shall be \$2,500 per accreditation.

(b) Laboratories that request special onsite inspections shall pay FSIS the actual cost of reasonable travel and other expenses necessary to perform the unscheduled or non-routine onsite inspections.
