compensation, in making contributions and contribution reports, in providing information relating to retirement claims, in providing information relating to unemployment and sickness claims, and in maintaining claims office facilities.

(b) Where the national emergency prevents employers from following these provisions in whole or in part, it shall be their responsibility to resume the payment of contributions and other

normal practices as quickly as possible in the post-attack period, to bring contribution accounts up to date, and to supply the Board with wage and service and other required information within the limits of available data withheld during the emergency.

(c) In a national emergency as defined in §375.2, contributions, communications, and other materials are to be mailed as set forth in §375.4.
