### Chamber Action

**Measures Introduced:** Twelve bills were introduced, as follows: S. 174–185. Page S653

**Measures Reported:** Reports were made as follows:

S. 1, to curb the practice of imposing unfunded Federal mandates on States and local governments; to strengthen the partnership between the Federal Government and State, local and tribal governments; to end the imposition, in the absence of full consideration by Congress, of Federal mandates on State, local, and tribal governments without adequate funding, in a manner that may displace other essential governmental priorities; and to ensure that the Federal Government pays the costs incurred by those governments in complying with certain requirements under Federal statutes and regulations, with amendments. (Budget) Page S646

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**Congressional Accountability Act:** Senate continued consideration of S. 2, to make certain laws applicable to the legislative branch of the Federal Government, taking action on amendments proposed thereto, as follows: Pages S621–42

Pending:

(1) Ford/Feingold Amendment No. 4, to prohibit the personal use of accrued frequent flyer miles by Members and employees of the Congress. Page S621

(2) McConnell Amendment No. 8 (to Amendment No. 4), to prohibit the personal use of accrued frequent flyer miles by Members and employees of the

Senate and clarify Senate regulations on the use of frequent flyer miles. Pages S641–42
