Measures Reported: Reports were made as follows:

Report to accompany S. 1254, to establish a comprehensive strategy for the elimination of market-distorting practices affecting the global steel industry. (S. Rept. No. 106–155)

Report to accompany H.R. 1833, to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 2000 and 2001 for the United States Customs Service for drug interdiction and other operations, for the Office of the United States Trade Representative, for the United States International Trade Commission. (S. Rept. No. 106–156) Page S10729

FALN Terrorist Clemency: Senate began consideration of the motion to proceed to the consideration of S.J. Res. 33, deploring the actions of President Clinton regarding granting clemency to the Armed Forces of National Liberation (the FALN) terrorists. Page S10720

A motion was entered to close further debate on the motion to proceed to the consideration of the resolution and, in accordance with the provisions of Rule XXII of the Standing Rules of the Senate, a vote on the cloture motion will occur on Monday, September 13, 1999. Page S10720

Hutchison Amendment No. 1603, to prohibit the use of funds for the purpose of issuing a notice of rulemaking with respect to the valuation of crude oil for royalty purposes until September 30, 2000. (By 2 yeas to 96 nays (Vote No. 267), Senate failed to table the amendment.) Page S10720
