The database includes both text and graphics from the beginning of the 103d Congress, 2d session (January 1994) forward. Customers can also access this information with WAIS client software, via telnet at [swais.access.gpo.gov](http://swais.access.gpo.gov), or dial-in using communications software and a modem at 202-512-1661.
