## Senate

### Chamber Action

*Routine Proceedings, pages S3177–S3210*

**Measures Introduced:** Four bills and two resolutions were introduced, as follows: S. 2894–2897, S. Res. 523, and S. Con. Res. 77. **Page S3206**

**Measures Reported:**

S. 2894, to establish requirements for private lenders to protect student borrowers receiving private educational loans. (S. Rept. No. 110–327)

S. 1810, to amend the Public Health Service Act to increase the provision of scientifically sound information and support services to patients receiving a positive test diagnosis for Down syndrome or other prenatally and postnatally diagnosed conditions, with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. **Page S3206**

**Measures Passed:**

**National Shaken Baby Syndrome Awareness Week:** Committee on the Judiciary was discharged from further consideration of S. Res. 518, designating the third week of April 2008 as “National Shaken Baby Syndrome Awareness Week”, and the resolution was then agreed to. **Page S3210**

**Measures Considered:**

**Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act—Cloture:** Senate began consideration of the motion to proceed to consideration of H.R. 2831, to amend title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990, and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to clarify that a discriminatory compensation decision or other practice that is unlawful under such Acts occurs each time compensation is paid

pursuant to the discriminatory compensation decision or other practice. **Page S3188**

A motion was entered to close further debate on the motion to proceed to consideration of the bill, and, in accordance with the provisions of Rule XXII of the Standing Rules of the Senate, a vote on cloture will occur on Wednesday, April 23, 2008. **Page S3188**

**Veterans’ Benefits Enhancement Act—Agreement:** A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that at approximately 11 a.m., on Tuesday, April 22, 2008, Senate resume consideration of the motion to proceed to consideration of S. 1315, to amend title 38, United States Code, to enhance life insurance benefits for disabled veterans. **Page S3211**
