Health Exchange Security and Transparency Act of 2014: The House passed H.R. 3811, to require notification of individuals of breaches of personally identifiable information through Exchanges under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, by a yea-and-nay vote of 291 yeas to 122 nays, Roll No. 11.
