RESOLUTIONS REPORTED FROM THE RULES COMMITTEE

REPORT

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 297, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives clause 4(b) of Rule XI (requiring a two-thirds vote to consider a rule on the same day as it is reported from the Committee on Rules) against the same-day consideration of certain resolutions reported during the remainder of the first session of the 104th Congress.

The resolution covers special rules that provide for the consideration or disposition of a measure, amendment, conference report or amendment reported in disagreement relating to the following items: a bill making general appropriations for fiscal year 1996; a bill or joint resolution making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 1996; a bill or joint resolution increasing or waiving the public debt limit; a bill to provide for a balanced budget by 2002; and a bill or resolution relating to the deployment of United States Armed Forces in and around the territory of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
