REPORT TO ACCOMPANY S. 1059, THE NATIONAL DE-
FENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT OF 1999

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 288]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 288, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution waives all points of order against the conference report to accompany S. 1059, the “National Defense Authorization Act of 1999,” and against its consideration.

The waiver of all points of order against the conference report and against its consideration is necessary because, for example, Sections 1018, 1211 and Title XXXII of the conference report are in violation of clause 9 of rule XXII (violating the scope of the conference) and Sections 1234 and 1063 of the conference report are in violation of clause 10 of rule XXII (prohibiting nongermane amendments in a conference report).
