Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules,

REPORT

[To accompany H. Res. 139]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House
Resolution 139, by a record vote of 7 to 1, report the same to the
House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of H.J. Res. 37, the
“Tax Limitation Constitutional Amendment,” under a structured
rule. The rule provides three hours of debate divided equally be-
tween the chairman and ranking minority member of the Commit-
tee on the Judiciary.

The resolution provides for one motion to amend if offered by the
Minority Leader or his designee, which shall be considered as read
and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided and
controlled by the proponent and an opponent. Finally, the rule pro-
vides for one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
