#### REVISED SUBALLOCATION OF BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014

The Committee on Appropriations submits the following report on the suballocation of budget allocations for fiscal year 2014 pursuant to section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974.

As required by section 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, this report subdivides the allocations of fiscal year 2014 spending authority to the House Committee on Appropriations established in H. Con. Res. 25 (113th Congress) and the accompanying report, H. Rept. 113-17, as given force and effect by section 3 of H. Res. 243 (113th Congress). The revised suballocations reflect permissible adjustments to the 302(a) allocations pursuant to section 603 of H. Con. Res. 25 and section 251(b) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act.
