

E. INDEX TO ENTRIES THAT MAY HAVE FEDERALISM IMPLICATIONS

Executive Order 13132 entitled “Federalism” (August 4, 1999, 64 FR 43255) directs agencies to have an accountable process to ensure meaningful and timely input by State and local officials in the development of regulatory policies that have “federalism implications.” This term refers to actions “that have substantial direct effects on the States, on the relationship between the national government and the States, or on the distribution of power and responsibilities among the various levels of government.” As part of this effort, agencies, other than independent regulatory agencies, include in their submissions for the Unified Agenda information on whether their regulatory actions have federalism implications.

The following index lists the regulatory actions in this publication that agencies believe may have federalism implications. The Sequence Number (Seq. No.) of the entry identifies the location of the entry in this edition. For further information, see the Regulatory Information Service Center’s Introduction to the Unified Agenda in Part II of this issue.
