A recorded vote by electronic device was ordered in the Committee of the Whole on the following amendments en bloc submitted by Mr. MCCOLLUM:

Page 37, strike lines 1 through 17 and insert the following:

"(c)(1) Any non-Federal funds received by the Corporation, and any funds received by any recipient from any source other than the Corporation, shall be accounted for and reported as receipts and disbursements separate and distinct from Corporation funds. Any funds so received, including funds derived from Interest on Lawyers Trust Accounts (IOLTA), may not be expended by recipients for any purpose prohibited by this title or the Legal Services Reauthorization Act of 1991. The Corporation shall not accept any non-Federal funds, and any recipient shall not accept funds from any source other than the Corporation, unless the Corporation or the recipient, as the case may be, notifies in writing the source of such funds that the funds may not be expended for any purpose prohibited by this title or the Legal Services Reauthorization Act of 1991.

"(2) Paragraph (1) shall not prevent recipients from—

"(A) receiving Indian tribal funds (including funds from private nonprofit organizations for the benefit of Indians or Indian tribes) and expending them in accordance with the specific purposes for which they are provided; or

"(B) using funds received from a source other than the Corporation to provide legal assistance to a client who is not an eligible client if such funds are used for the specific purposes for which such funds were received, except that such funds may not be expended by recipients for any purpose prohibited by this title or the Legal Services Reauthorization Act of 1991 (other than any requirement regarding the eligibility of clients)."

Res. 287) setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for the fiscal years 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, and 1997; together with the amendment of the Senate thereto, was taken from the Speaker's table.

49.37 MOTION TO INSTRUCT CONFEREES—H. CON. RES. 287

Mr. GRADISON moved that the managers on the part of the House at the conference with the Senate on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses on the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 287) setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for the fiscal years 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, and 1997, be instructed to include in the conference report the provision in section 14 of the Senate amendment (relating to the adoption of a joint resolution to amend the U.S. Constitution to require a balanced budget).
