¶97.23 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 4394

Mr. HALL of Ohio, by direction of the Committee on Rules, reported (Rept. No. 102-784) the resolution (H. Res. 540) providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 4394) to amend title 46, United States Code, to require merchants mariners' documents for certain seamen.

When said resolution and report were referred to the House Calendar and ordered printed.

¶97.24 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 5466

Mr. HALL of Ohio, by direction of the Committee on Rules, reported (Rept. No. 102-785) the resolution (H. Res. 541) providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 5466) to amend the Federal Aviation Act of 1958 to enhance competition among air carriers by prohibiting an air carrier who operates a computer reservation system from discriminating against other air carriers participating in the system and among travel agents which subscribe to the system, and for other purposes.

¶97.25 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF H. CON. RES. 246

Mr. HALL of Ohio, by direction of the Committee on Rules, reported (Rept. No. 102-786) the resolution (H. Res. 542) providing for the consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 246) expressing the sense of Congress with respect to the relation of trade agreements to health, safety, labor, and environmental laws of the United States.

¶97.26 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 3603

H.R. 2092. An Act to carry out obligations of the United States under the United Nations Charter and other international agreements pertaining to the protection of human rights by establishing a civil action for recovery of damages from an individual who engages in torture or extrajudicial killing;
H.R. 4113. An Act to permit the transfer before the expiration of the otherwise applicable 60-day congressional review period of the obsolete training aircraft carrier U.S.S. Lexington to the Corpus Christi Area Convention and Visitors Bureau, Corpus Christi, Texas, for use as a naval museum and memorial;
H.J. Res. 343. Joint resolution to designate March 12, 1992, as "Girl Scouts of the United States of America 80th Anniversary Day";
