

recommendation that the amendments be agreed to and that the bill, as amended, do pass.

By unanimous consent, the previous question was ordered on the bill.

Mr. SOLOMON demanded a separate vote on each of the following amendments: on page 20, line 9 (the COPPER-SMITH amendment); on page 20, line 9 (the MARKEY amendment); and on page 21, line 16 (the SLATTERY amendment).

The following remaining amendments, reported from the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union were then agreed to:

On page 20, line 10, before the period insert the following: “. of which \$10,000,000 shall be for hydrogen research and development”

Page 21, line 22, strike the period and insert in lieu thereof the following: “. Provided further, that none of the funds made available under this section for Department of Energy facilities may be obligated or expended for food, beverages, receptions, parties, country club fees, plants or flowers pursuant to any cost-reimbursable contract.”

Page 23, line 14, strike “\$3,572,472,000” and insert “\$3,572,198,000”.

Page 38, after line 19, add the following new sections:

SEC. 502. COMPLIANCE WITH BUY AMERICAN ACT

No funds appropriated pursuant to this Act may be expended by an entity unless the entity agrees that in expending the assistance the entity will comply with sections 2 through 4 of the Act of March 3, 1933 (41 U.S.C. 10a-10c, popularly known as the “Buy American Act”).

SEC. 503. SENSE OF CONGRESS; REQUIREMENT REGARDING NOTICE

(a) PURCHASE OF AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS.—In the case of any equipment or products that may be authorized to be purchased with financial assistance provided under this Act, it is the sense of the Congress that entities receiving such assistance, purchase only American-made equipment and products.

(b) NOTICE TO RECIPIENTS OF ASSISTANCE.—In providing financial assistance under this Act, the head of each Federal agency shall provide to each recipient of the assistance a notice describing the statement made in subsection (a) by the Congress.

SEC. 504. PROHIBITION OF CONTRACTS.

If it has been finally determined by a court or Federal agency that any person intentionally affixed a label bearing a “Made in America” inscription, or any inscription with the same meaning, to any product sold in or shipped to the United States that is not made in the United States, such person shall be ineligible to receive any contract or sub-contract made with funds provided pursuant to this Act, pursuant to the debarment, suspension, and ineligibility procedures described in section 9.400 through 9.409 of title 48, Code of Federal Regulations.
