When Mr. BROWN of California, Chairman, reported that the Committee, having had under consideration said bill, had directed him to report the same back to the House with sundry amendments adopted by the Committee with the recommendation that the amendments be agreed to and that the bill, as amended, do pass.

By unanimous consent, the previous question was ordered.

Mr. WALKER demanded a separate vote on the amendment on page 19, line 3 (the HUNTER amendment).

Mr. SMITH of Iowa demanded a separate vote on each of the following amendments: on page 33, line 21 (the WALKER amendment); and on page 55, line 8 (the PENNY amendment, as amended).

The following remaining amendments, reported from the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union were then agreed to:

Page 62, line 11, strike "\$593,000" and insert "\$186,000".

Page 62, line 14, strike the word "In" and all that follows through line 18.

At the end of the bill, add the following new sections:

**SEC. . SENSE OF CONGRESS; REQUIREMENT REGARDING NOTICE.**

(a) PURCHASE OF AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS.—In the case of any equipment or products that may be authorized to be purchased with financial assistance provided under this Act, it is the sense of the Congress that entities receiving such assistance should, in expending the assistance, to the extent feasible, purchase only American-made equipment and products.

(b) NOTICE TO RECIPIENTS OF ASSISTANCE.—In providing financial assistance under this Act, the Head of the agency shall provide to each recipient of the assistance a notice describing the statement made in subsection (a) by the Congress.

Page 19, line 3, strike "\$999,000,000" and insert "\$1,059,000,000".
