§82.12 PROVIDING FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADJOURNMENT OF THE TWO HOUSES

Mr. DIAZ-BALART, by direction of the Committee on Rules, called up the following resolution (H. Res. 465):

Resolved, That upon the adoption of this resolution it shall be in order, any rule of the House to the contrary notwithstanding, to consider in the House a concurrent resolution providing for adjournment of the House and Senate for the Independence Day district work period.

§82.13 WORDS TAKEN DOWN

Mr. OBEY during debate addressed the House and, during the course of his remarks,

Mr. HAYWORTH demanded that certain words be taken down.

The Clerk read the words taken down as follows:

And to the gentleman from Arizona, every time somebody says something you don't like, you open your mouth and you start shouting from your seat. You are one of the most impolite Members I have ever seen in my service in this House.

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mr. LAHOOD, held the words taken down to be unparliamentary, and said:

"In the opinion of the Chair, the last sentence of the gentleman from Wisconsin constitutes a personality in violation of clause 1 of rule XIV."

By unanimous consent, the words ruled unparliamentary were stricken from the Congressional Record.

By unanimous consent, Mr. OBEY was permitted to proceed in order.

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mr. LAHOOD, responding to a parliamentary inquiry of the gentleman from Connecticut [Mr. GEJDENSON] as to the proper course when a speaking Member is disrupted, said:

"The Chair will take the initiative to maintain order in the Chamber when Members are speaking. The Chair would enlist the assistance of all Members in maintaining the spirit of mutual courtesy and comity that properly dignifies the proceedings of the House. Members who are under recognition should not be disrupted by other Members."

After further debate, On motion of Mr. DIAZ-BALART, the previous question was ordered on the resolution to its adoption or rejection.

The question being put, viva voce, Will the House agree to said resolution?

The SPEAKER pro tempore, Mr. LAHOOD, announced that the yeas had it.

Mr. MOAKLEY objected to the vote on the ground that a quorum was not present and not voting.

A quorum not being present, The roll was called under clause 4, rule XV, and the call was taken by electronic device.
