Page 9, strike line 16 and all that follows
thereafter through page 10, line 10, and insert
the following new section:

SEC. 9. FILINGS BY NON-MEMBERS OF INFORMA-
TION OFFERED AS A COMPLAINT.

(a) FILINGS SPONSORED BY MEMBERS.—
Clause 4(e)(2)(B) of Rule X of the rules of the
House of Representatives is amended by
striking "or submitted to", by striking "a
complaint" and inserting "information offer-
ed as a complaint", and by amending
clause (ii) to read as follows:

"(ii) upon receipt of information offered as
a complaint, in writing and under oath, from
an individual not a Member of the House pro-
vided that a Member of the House certifies in
writing to the committee that he or she be-
lieves the information is submitted in good
faith and warrants the review and consider-
ation of the committee.

Page 10, strike line 12 and all that follows
thereafter through page 11, line 23, and on
line 24, strike "(b) TIME FOR DETERMINA-
TION.—"

Whole on the following amendment
submitted by Mr. TAUZIN:

Page 14, line 21, after the period, add the
following new sentence: "If 180 calendar days
have passed since a motion to establish an
investigative subcommittee did not prevail,
the complaint shall be dismissed without
prejudice."

Page 15, line 12, before the quotation
marks, add the following new sentence: "If
180 calendar days have passed since a motion
to establish an investigative subcommittee
did not prevail, the complaint shall be dis-
missed without prejudice."

Page 22, line 16, strike "and", on line 20,
strike the period and insert "; and", and
after line 20, insert the following new para-
graph:

(9) If 180 calendar days have passed since a
motion to establish an investigative sub-
committee did not prevail, the committee
shall send a letter to the complainant and
the respondent stating that the complaint
has been dismissed without prejudice.
