

Lot 3, section 25, township 11 north, range 7 west, Seward meridian, Alaska, containing twenty-five and twenty-two one-hundredths acres: *Provided*, That the purchase price for the land shall be the reasonable value thereof without improvements, as determined by the Secretary of the Interior but not less than \$1.25 per acre.

CHAPTER 396

AN ACT

For the relief of Bruno Michael Kiuru.

July 26, 1955
[H. R. 926]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Bruno Michael Kiuru shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of this Act, upon payment of the required visa fee. Upon the granting of permanent residence to such alien as provided for in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper quota-control officer to deduct one number from the appropriate quota for the first year that such quota is available.

AN ACT

For the relief of Evagelos B. Tzarimas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 101 (a) (27) (A) and 205 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, the minor child, Evagelos B. Tzarimas, shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien child of Mr. and Mrs. Enggill A. Zayemopoulos.
