

SEC. 2. Nothing contained in this Act shall be deemed to increase the retired or retirement pay received by the said Major General Hanford MacNider and no other benefits shall accrue to him by virtue of the enactment thereof.

CHAPTER 1040

AN ACT

August 9, 1956
[H. R. 10624]

Relating to intercorporate relations between the General Public Utilities Corporation, a corporation organized and operating in the United States, and the Manila Electric Company.

General Public
Utilities Corp.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That no law of the United States shall be held to require, or to authorize any department or independent agency of the Government to require, the General Public Utilities Corporation, a corporation organized and operating in the United States, to divest itself of control of, or any interest in, the Manila Electric Company, which produces and distributes electricity in and around the city of Manila in the Republic of the Philippines.

To provide for the retirement of Major General Hanford MacNider, Army of the United States (retired), to the grade of lieutenant general on the retired list.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That Major General Hanford MacNider, Army of the United States (retired), shall be advanced on the retired list to the grade of lieutenant general effective as of the date of enactment of this Act.
