For the relief of John J. Fedor.

John J. Fedor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Postmaster General of the United States be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to pay John J. Fedor, of Clifton, New Jersey, in full settlement of all claims against the United States, an amount he was entitled to for twenty-two and seven-eighths days of annual leave as a rural carrier at Clifton, New Jersey, during July 1955.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 203 (a) (3) and 205 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Sylvia Ottila Tenyi shall be held and considered to be the child of Irene Tenyi Petercsak, a lawfully resident alien of the United States.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 101 (a) (27) (A) and 205 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, the minor child, Vanja Stipic, shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien child of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Kovach, citizens of the United States.

Skye, a citizen of the United States.
