For the relief of Evagelia Elliopulos.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 101(a)(27)(A) and 205 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, the minor child, Evagelia Elliopulos, shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien child of George L. Elliopulos and Agapi Elliopulos, citizens of the United States: *Provided,* That no natural parent of Evagelia Elliopulos, by virtue of such parentage, shall be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 101(a)(27)(A) and 205 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, the minor child, Ivan (John) Persic, shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien child of Louis Persic, a citizen of the United States: *Provided,* That no natural parent of Ivan (John) Persic, by virtue of such parentage, shall be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.

Grewal, Jeat S. Grewal, Gurmale S. Grewal, and Tahil S. Grewal shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien children of Sarwan S. Grewal, a citizen of the United States: *Provided,* That the natural parents of Lushmon S. Grewal, Jeat S. Grewal, Gurmale S. Grewal, and Tahil S. Grewal shall not, by virtue of such parentage, be afforded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
