Chambers by quitclaim deed all right, title, and interest of the United States in and to such tract of land, more particularly described as follows: The southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 34, township 31 north, range 100 west, sixth principal meridian, Fremont County, Wyoming, consisting of forty acres more or less.

SEC. 2. The conveyance authorized by the first section of this Act shall be made by the Secretary of Agriculture without consideration, but the said Harriet C. Chambers shall bear any expenses incident to the preparation of the legal documents necessary or appropriate to carry out the first section of this Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in the administration of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Dinesh Kumar Poddar and Girish Kumar Poddar may be classified as children within the meaning of section 101(b)(1)(F) of the Act, upon approval of petitions filed in their behalf by Mr. and Mrs. Bhagwati P. K. Podar, a lawfully resident alien and a citizen of the United States, respectively, pursuant to section 204 of the Act.

For the relief of David B. Glidden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That David B. Glidden, a former member of the United States Army (service number RA11393462), is hereby relieved of liability to the United States in the amount of \$750, the amount of an overpayment to him of Army proficiency pay in the period beginning October 1, 1963, and ending July 31, 1964, because of an administrative error. In the audit and settlement of the accounts of any certifying or disbursing officer of the United States, credit shall be given for any amount for which liability is relieved by this Act.
