For the relief of Maria Rossi.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of sections 203(a) (1) and 204 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Maria Rossi shall be held and considered to be the natural-born alien daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Eugenio Carlo Moruzzi, citizens of the United States: Provided, That the natural parents or brothers or sisters of the beneficiary shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.*

## AN ACT

For the relief of Mrs. Emilie Boulay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for purposes of determining the entitlement of Mrs. Emilie Boulay, of Berlin, New Hampshire, to benefits under title II of the Social Security Act for months after November 1960 on the basis of the wages and self-employment income of the late Napoleon Boulay (social security account Numbered 001-12-7112), if the said Mrs. Emilie Boulay files application for such benefits within six months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the marriage entered into by the said Mrs. Emilie Boulay and Napoleon Boulay on May 15, 1905, shall be held and considered to have been a valid marriage under the laws of the State in which the said Napoleon Boulay was domiciled at the time of his death.*

For the relief of Doctor Eric J. Lazaro.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in the administration of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Eric J. Lazaro shall be held and considered to have complied with the provisions of section 316 of that Act as they relate to residence and physical presence.*
