

Private Law 89-429

AN ACT

For the relief of certain individuals.

November 2, 1966
[H. R. 14864]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That each individual or estate named in section 2 of this Act is relieved of liability to pay to the United States the amount set forth opposite his name in such section. Such amounts represent overpayments of compensation made as a result of administrative error to such individuals while they were employed at the Charleston Naval Shipyard, Charleston, South Carolina. In the audit and settlement of the accounts of any certifying or disbursing officer of the United States, credit shall be given for amounts for which liability is relieved by this section.

SEC. 3. (a) The Secretary of the Treasury is authorized and directed to pay, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to each individual listed in section 2 of this Act an amount equal to the aggregate of the amounts paid by him, or withheld from sums otherwise due him, with respect to his indebtedness to the United States specified in section 2 of this Act.

(b) No part of the amount appropriated in subsection (a) of this section in excess of 10 per centum thereof shall be paid or delivered to or received by any agent or attorney on account of services rendered in connection with this claim, and the same shall be unlawful, any contract to the contrary notwithstanding. Any person violating the provisions of this subsection shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$1,000.
